A first generation Cuban American from Miami, Paolo is best known for the two seasons he worked as a regular cast member on LOGO'S BIG GAY SKETCH SHOW. In television he had a recurring role as the Justice of the Peace as well as Dr.

Harrison, a liver specialist on ONE LIFE TO LIVE (where he operated on Vicky Buchanan's daughter Jess. Unfortunately, a bomb was planted in the hospital and the operation was unsuccessful. Fortunately, Dr. Harrison survived with a faint heartbeat and lived to operate again on the weakened Jess). Yes, that is a true story! Most recently Paolo performed PIECES in LA & an extended run in New York. He also gave away his Latin lover secrets in the movie FATTIES. He was the title character in the independent film CHOKING MAN which played at the Tribeca Film Festival and The Sundance Channel. Sedaris' sardonic humor and incisive social critique have since made him one of NPR's most popular and humorous commentators and a bestselling author in the United States and abroad. The great skill with which Sedaris slices through euphemisms and political correctness proves that he is a master of satire. Everywhere he goes David Sedaris delights his audience with his irreverent style and great humor. In addition to his commentaries on NPR, David Sedaris is the author of the best sellers BARREL FEVER and NAKED. His other book, a collection of Christmas related stories, is entitled HOLIDAY ON ICE. His most recent book of essays, ME TALK PRETTY ONE DAY, was published in June 2000 became an immediate bestseller. David and his sister, Amy Sedaris, have collaborated under the name The Talent Family and written several plays which have been produced at La Mama and at Lincoln Center in New York City. These plays include STUMP THE HOST, STITCHES, ONE WOMAN SHOE, which received an obie award, INCIDENT AT COBBLER'S KNOB and THE BOOK OF LIZ. David is a regular contributor to Esquire magazine and his essays have also appeared in The New Yorker, Allure and Travel and Leisure. Sedaris' original radio pieces can often be heard on public radio's THIS AMERICAN LIFE, distributed nationally by WBEZ in Chicago, as well as BBC radio in London. David Sedaris currently resides in Paris.

DANIEL HENNING (Founding Artistic Director) most recently directed the world premiere of THE COST OF THE ERECTION and the West Coast premiere of DUSK RINGS A BELL. His recent revival of The Blank's 1994 production of the pro-labor 1937 union musical THE CRADLE WILL ROCK was nominated for three LA Weekly Awards. Prior to that Henning directed West Coast Premieres of Michael John LaChiusa's musical SEE WHAT I WANNA SEE (LA Weekly nominations for "Musical of the Year," "Direction of a Musical"), Christopher Durang's WHY TORTURE IS WRONG, AND THE PEOPLE WHO LOVE THEM (LA Weekly noms: "Comedy Direction"), and the World Premiere of SETUP & PUNCH, a new musical by Mark Saltzman (LA Weekly noms: "Best Musical", "Best Director of a Musical").

His most recent television work is an episode of MTV's ROB DYRDEK'S FANTASY FACTORY where Daniel wrote and directed a mini-musical LIVIN IT! for Rob and the cast. He appears in the episode as well. Henning's debut as a playwright was DICKIE & BABE: THE TRUTH ABOUT LEOPOLD & LOEB, which played a twice-extended run at The Blank. Henning won the NAACP Theatre Award for "Best Director" for LaChiusa & George C. Wolfe's THE WILD PARTY ("Best Production" -LA Drama Critics Circle Award, NAACP Theatre Award, BackStage West Garland Award and 17 other awards). He conceived and directed the world premiere LaChiusa revue HOTEL C'EST L'AMOUR (LA Weekly Award), directed The Blank's LOBSTER ALICE, starring Noah Wyle & Nicholas Brendon (LA Weekly Award, LA Drama Critics Circle Award), and the West Coast Premiere of SPEECH & DEBATE by Stephen Karam, a three-time winner in The Blank's Young Playwrights Festival.

Henning made his Lincoln Center directorial debut with THE GIRLY SHOW with Mr. LaChiusa. Henning directed the World Premiere of Saltzman's MR. SHAW GOES TO HOLLYWOOD (OC Weekly Award) at the Laguna Playhouse and created the star-studded benefit WHAT A PAIR! On The Blank's Mainstage he has also directed: FIRST LADY SUITE (NAACP nom), a Jazz Age version of LES LIAISONS DANGEREUSES, AS IS, FILL IN THE BLANK (comedies by David Ives), George Furth's PRECIOUS SONS (revised by Furth & Henning) starring Nora Dunn & Gregory Jbara (BackStage Garland Award, "Best Director"), THE WHY starring Noah Wyle & James Marsters (Ovation nomination), HELLO AGAIN (Ovation Award, 3 Garland Awards) with Susan Egan, Marcia Strassman & Richard Kline, BREAKING THE CODE with Dennis Christopher & Jeremy Sisto (LADCC Award - "Best Production"), the Los Angeles premiere of CHESS with Marcia Mitzman Gaven & Douglas Sills (2 LADCC Awards, 2 Ovation Awards), a film noir version of LOOT, and SKY'S END, a musical which grew out of The Blank's nationwide Young Playwrights Festival - a 19 year-old competition for playwrights 19 and younger.

In March 2008, Henning & The Blank Theatre were awarded the Hollywood Arts Council's "Charlie Award" for "pursuing artistic excellence and for nurturing the next generation of playwrights in the heart of Hollywood." And in the fall of 2011, a resolution was passed in honor of The Blank and Henning by the Los Angeles City Council. The resolution read, in part: "In the City of Angels, The Blank is truly an angel." Henning also serves on the Executive Committee of the Hollywood Arts Council, the Western Regional Council for the Actor's Fund and is a graduate of NYU's Tisch School of the Arts, Circle in the Square Theatre School, and American Conservatory Theatre.

ED MURPHY (Managing Director) now in his his fourth season with The Blank, Ed brings a vast and varied background in live entertainment to his position of Managing Director. His extensive background in marketing includes Vice President of Sales and Marketing for the Harlem Globetrotters, National Director of Marketing and Promotions at Tickets.com. His venue background includes Managing Director of Kodak Theatre, Director of Booking and Event Services at Staples Center and Executive Director of the Mullins Center at the University of Massachusetts Amherst where is also served as Adjunct Faculty. He was also an integral part of the Venue Management team at the 1996 Atlanta Olympic Games. At EJM Productions he offered a myriad of consulting, marketing and production services to clients in the non-profit, television and sports industries. A native of Boston, MA, he is a graduate of Georgetown University.

NOAH WYLE (Artistic Producer/Producer), best known for his role as Dr. John Carter on NBC's long running hit, E.R., has served as Artistic Producer for The Blank since 1997. His history with the company, however, dates

back to its inception, as he was cast in its inaugural production of SEXUAL PERVERSITY IN CHICAGO in 1993. Whether acting, directing or producing for The Blank's Living Room Series, Young Playwright's Festival, or mainstage, he remains as committed as ever to assisting The Blank achieve its goal of becoming the FIRST regional theatre in Hollywood. He splits his time between Santa Ynez, CA and Los Angeles, with his two beautiful children, Owen and Auden, and can be seen in the TNT drama, FALLING SKIES.

MATTHEW GRABER (Producing Director) joined The Blank team just over a year ago. Since that time he served as producer on the The Young Playwrights Festival as well as mainstages THE CRADLE WILL ROCK, THE TEMPERAMENTALS, DUSK RINGS A BELL, THE SANTALAND DIARIES and THE COST OF THE ERECTION. Before that he spent the past five years serving as the Producing Artistic Director of the Shawnee Summer Theatre in Indiana. During that time the theatre achieved record setting years in attendance, contributions and overall revenue. In 2010, Shawnee was one of 200 nonprofit organizations to win the Chase Community Giving contest out of over 500,000 eligible. When not producing Matt also enjoys writing and directing. Some of his favorite directing projects have been SHERLOCK HOLMES: THE FINAL ADVENTURE (Shawnee Theatre), TWO MUFUKA'S SOME SEX AND A CRAB (Long Beach State) and Steven Belber's FINALLY (Theaterhaus in G7: Mannheim, Germany). His original play MY DINNER WITH A ZOMBIE was one of the top selling shows at the Indianapolis Fringe Festival in 2007. Matt would like to thank Angie for her love and support over the years.

KIRSTEN SANDERSON (Director of New Play Development) has directed new works for the stage by Michael John LaChiusa, Craig Lucas, Shel Silverstein, Steven Schwartz and Blake Edwards, among others. She has taught Music Theatre Performance at Playwrights Horizons Theatre School, NYU, the Eugene O'Neil Center's National Theatre Institute and at AMDA Los Angeles. Kirsten has spent the last 17 years as a directing and producing associate to her mentor the late filmmaker Blake Edwards.
